Litton Parish Council is committed to making our website accessible to as many people as possible. You should be able to:

- zoom in up to 300% without text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the site using a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech-recognition software
- listen to most of the site using a screen reader

We aim to use clear and simple language throughout the website.

How accessible this website is

Some parts of this website are not fully accessible:

- text does not always reflow into a single column when the browser window is resized
- line height and text spacing cannot be adjusted
- some older PDF documents are not fully accessible
- some online forms are difficult to use with a keyboard
- there is no “skip to main content” option
- the map on the Contact Us page has limited magnification
- some focus indicators may not meet WCAG 2.2 visibility requirements
- some clickable areas may not meet the WCAG 2.2 minimum target size
- some components may require dragging movements
